FOT-NET 2 (FP7, 2011 – 2013)

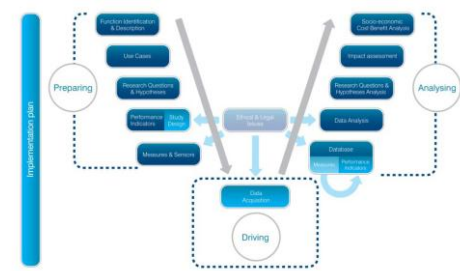
