

# FOT-NET DATA

- FOT-Net is a networking platform open to all stakeholders interested in FOTs, established in 2008. More than 30 organisations participate
- FOT-Net Data is a 3-year support action project (2014–2016, €1.8m) with main objectives to:
  - Support efficient sharing and re-use of FOT datasets
  - Develop and promote a framework for sharing data, maintain FESTA
  - Build a detailed catalogue of available data and tools
  - Operate the international networking platform for FOT activities



# C-ITS FIELD TESTS IN EUROPE

- First phase of C-ITS test projects ~2010–2015, e.g. DRIVE C2X (including simTD, SCORE@F), FOTsis and Compass4D
- Good technical progress, but business and privacy models need further collaboration
  - The EC has since set up a C-ITS Platform to support deployment, several actors working on remaining issues
- Next phase of testing could be said to be the corridor projects, demonstrating cross-border interoperability: Cooperative ITS Corridor, SCOOP@F, NordicWay etc

# H2020

- EU Research and Innovation programme 2014–2020
- The next calls for C-ITS and automated driving test proposals open in mid-October
  - Support for large-scale C-ITS demonstration projects, size > €10m (MG-6.2)
  - Several projects for automated and connected driving under ART (Automated Road Transport) call
  - Proposals are to include data management and collaboration plans – they can refer to FOT-Net
- Access to data is a critical topic for C-ITS, how to encourage and regulate it
